Key Objectives of the Role

We require a 1st Team Doctor for the Medical team. Delivering top class medical services and the highest standards of professional care for our players. The role requires an individual with excellent clinical experience and skills.

Main Duties/ Responsibilities

- Contribute to a positive working culture by fostering a work environment that is appropriate to our values; professionalism, respect, integrity, discipline, and effort
- In-person consultations one day per week available for significant injuries or health concerns
- Attend the Club's First Team home fixtures and any other matches as requested by the Club
- Organise Team Doctor Match day cover if cannot attend fixtures
- To be responsible for pitch-side assessment and treatment of players during training and matches
- Liaise with the Lead/Head Physio - Sport therapist, Medical team and healthcare professionals for the adequate provision of suitable medical care for the Players
- Need to be able to prescribe medication for our players if needed
- Therapeutic Use (TUE's), carry out required administrative duties for first team players with accuracy and speed
- Maintain and ensure up to date up to date medical records on all first team players ensuring UK Anti Doping (UKAD) and FA Anti Doping regulations are adhered to at all times, and any requirements from UKAD or FA Anti Doping are actioned immediately
- Organise and lead with the Lead/Head Physio Sport therapist all medical testing and cardiac screening in conjunction with external service providers
- In conjunction with the Lead/Head Physiotherapist - Sport Therapist management of the Ultraling Cardiac System.

Attendance of Medical Personnel/Medical Facilities

- Each club must have in attendance a Team Doctor at all home matches throughout the season and pre-season, in accordance with the Competition Rules
- The Primary Club Doctor must arrive at least 2 hours before the match kicks off and remain at the end of the game to assist the other medical staff with any player injuries
- The home club's doctor must visit both the home and away clubs' dressing rooms before leaving the ground
- London City Lionesses require a minimum of 2 hours prior to Kick Off at Home fixtures.



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Sports Medicine Qualifications / Requirements

- Be fully registered and licensed to practice by the GMC
- Have appropriate medical indemnity to treat/advise FA WSL and FA WC players
- The FA Level 5 Advanced Trauma Medical Management in Football (ATMMiF) or IMMOFP
- Diploma in Sport and Exercise Medicine or an Equivalent or Higher professional qualification
- Complete UKAD Clean Sport Advisor - this can be completed Online.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

- As part of the FA Clinical Governance Framework and Licence Requirements
- Team Doctors employed by the club shall continue to keep abreast of current research and evidence based practice in their field with a focus on sports related injury and rehabilitation research
- Practitioners should have undertaken CPD in line with their professional body guidelines and comply with the GMC's requirements of annual appraisal and revalidation.

FA Performance Support Regulations

- The Primary Team Doctor must abide by the GMC code of conduct and **all current** FA Performance Support Regulations.

All other duties that may arise from time to time and fall within the scope of the role.

- Previous experience treating professional athletes is desirable
- Previous experience within professional women's sport/football is also desirable
- Excellent organisation and planning skills with attention to detail
- Empathy and a good listener with a high degree of integrity
- Excellent communication skills with the ability to build meaningful relationships
- Experience in a fast paced environment and used to working to deadlines and under pressure
- Be willing to stand alone, make difficult decisions/be unpopular
- Critically Analyse Information and make sound judgements
- Aware of diversity and equality challenges in football
- Strong IT skills, proficient In Microsoft office and digital medical applications
- Ability to work flexibly, including weekends and independent travel
